For Friday roll up eclectic competitions, player handicaps shall be decreased (cut) for Stableford scores between 41-43 by 1, for scores between 44-46 by 2, for scores between 47-49 by 3, for scores over 49 by 4 and for scores less than 25 increased by 1. This only applies to the eclectic competitions and does not affect CONGU handicaps. On Friday qualifier days players shall use their CONGU handicap to record their CONGU Stableford scores on their scorecard. The competition organiser records the gross scores from the Friday qualifier scorecards on the computer and calculates the eclectic Stableford scores using the eclectic handicap valid on that day. The handicap secretary will process the qualifier scorecards as now. Before processing the eclectic competition scores, the player's CONGU handicap is checked with the current CONGU handicaps list and updated where necessary. The eclectic handicaps are then compared with the current CONGU handicaps. If the player's CONGU handicap is lower than the eclectic handicap then the eclectic handicap remains unchanged. If the player's CONGU handicap is the same as the eclectic handicap then the eclectic handicap remains unchanged. On the 1st day of January, May and September the eclectic handicaps shall be adjusted to be the same value as the CONGU handicaps. The competition organiser's decision is final.
